4. How do I become a Notary Public?
 - ▶ Check with another Notary in your office or contact the Secretary of State's Office, Index Department, Notary Section, 111 East Monroe, Springfield, IL 62756
 - ▶ Contact an Insurance Company who handles "Surety Bonds" and they will have the required paperwork
5. Where do I obtain my Notary Certificate?
 - ▶ You will receive a letter from the Ogle County Clerk's Office informing you that your Notary Commission has arrived.

6. Do I need to file an Assumed Business Name?
 - ▶ Anyone doing business in Ogle County who is not a Corporation and is not using his/her full name in the name of business, must file an Assumed Name.
7. How do I obtain copies of a Birth, Death or Marriage Certificate?
 - ▶ Go to Home page and click on “Downloads” button and download form
8. Can I get someone else's Birth Certificate?
 - ▶ No. You are entitled to certified copies of your own (if over 18 years of age) and your children's. However, records over 75 years old are available for genealogy.
9. Where do I get copies of my military discharge papers?

10. Where do I file an Economic Interest Statement?

11. Where do I pay my Real Estate Taxes?
